Associate Membership - \$40

1. Must be a NASS Associate Member in good standing.
2. Does not have to own a horse registered with the Shagya Registry of North America (SHARONA), but may do so.
3. Does not have voting privileges.
4. May request NASS promotional materials for horse fair booths, etc.
5. May participate in NASS educational functions, inspections, judge training.
6. Receive the NASS Newsletter.
7. Post NASS registered horses for sale on website.

Junior Membership (Member under 18 years) - \$25

1. Must be a NASS Junior Member in good standing.
2. Must ride or own a horse registered with the Shagya Registry of North America (SHARONA).
3. Does not have voting privileges.
4. May request NASS promotional materials for horse fair booths, etc.
5. May participate in NASS functions (Awards programs, etc.).
6. May serve on NASS Committees but may not serve as Chair.
7. Receive the NASS Newsletter.
8. Post NASS registered horses for sale on website.

Lifetime Active Membership - \$200

1. Must be a NASS Member in good standing.
2. Voting privileges providing a horse registered with the Shagya Registry of North America (SHARONA) is owned.
